Your personal data will not be transferred to recipients located in countries outside the EEA (European Economic Area).
5. The personal data can be processed as long as it is necessary to achieve the purposes of processing indicated in point 3.

7. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, that is, the Office of Personal Data Protection, if you decide that the processing of your data is in breach of the provisions of GDPR.
